The Pharmacy and Poisons Board (PPB) is Kenya's National Medicines Regulatory Authority established in 1957 under the Pharmacy and Poisons Act, Chapter 244 of the Laws of Kenya. The Board regulates the Practice of Pharmacy and the Manufacture and Trade in Medical Products and Health Technologies.

The Board aims to optimize mechanisms to ensure that pharmaceutical practitioners released into the market are competent and fit to practice. Therefore, the Board seeks to recruit qualified

candidates to fill the following positions:

Position: Medical Devices Expert

Job Number of Posts: Nine (9)

Terms of Service: On Ad Hoc Basis as and when Need Arises

Experience: Atleast five (5) years in the medical Technologies and

related sector

Terms of Service: Three Years Renewable Term

JOB DESCRIPTION

The holder will be required to provide expertise and technical support in the conduct of technical file assessment for Medical Devices

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The roles and responsibilities of the Medical Devices Expert include:

1) Developing and reviewing PPB guidelines on the quality, safety and

- performance of Medical Devices.
- 2) Providing advice to the Board on the regulation of Medical Devices
- 3) Provide advice on investigation of Field safety Corrective Notifications associated with Medical Devices
- 4) Support PPB in review of Technical file assessment for the common submission dossier template for Marketing Authorization.
- 5) Provide guidance and development of standards to be used in the regulation of medical devices
- 6) Any other assigned duties in the purview of medical devices
- 7) Assist in evaluation of clinical trials involving Medical Devices.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- 1) Have Bachelor's degree in any of the following disciplines: Pharmacy (B. Pharm), Medicine and Surgery (MBChB), Biomedical Engineering, Biomedical Scientist, Medical Laboratory Sciences, or any other equivalent and relevant qualification from a recognized Institution
- 2) Have a Master's Degree in any of the following fields: Biomedical Engineering, Physicist, Biomedical Sciences Pharmaceutical Sciences, Clinical Studies, Microbiology, Biotechnology, or any other equivalent and relevant qualification from a recognized institution
- 3) Be registered with a relevant Professional body;
- 4) Valid practicing license;
- 5) Proficiency in computer applications; and
- 6) Fulfill the requirements of Chapter Six (6) of the Constitution.

- 5. Click the 'submit' button and logout.

- 4. Shortlisted candidates will be contacted and required to avail their original and certified copies of relevant certificates, detailed Curriculum Vitae, and original national identity card during the interview.

- 5. Persons with disability, female candidates, marginalized and minority groups are encouraged to apply.
- 6. Successful candidates will be required to submit clearance certificates from KRA; EACC; Credit Reference Bureau and the Kenya Police as per Chapter Six of the Constitution.
