Globe Pharmacy Ltd is recalling **CBLO01CE & CBLO02CE** batches of Clindar B capsules due to the crumbling and breaking of capsules, exposing the contents.

Action for healthcare professionals

Quarantine all remaining stock and stop further distribution, sale, issuing, and use of the affected batches immediately. You will be contacted by Globe Pharmacy Ltd to arrange for the return of the product.

Advice for patients and caregivers

No action is required for patients as this is a wholesaler/distributor level of recall. Patients should continue taking other batches of the product other than the impacted batches and as prescribed by the healthcare professional.
