Quarantine all remaining stock and stop further distribution, sale, issuing, or use of batches **79887**, **82172**, **82173**, and **82174** immediately and contact Laboratory and Allied Limited Ltd to arrange return.

Action for patients and caregivers

No further action is required by patients as this is a Retail/hospital Pharmacy and Wholesaler/Distributor level recall. Patients should continue to take medicines from other batches of this product other than the impacted batches and as prescribed by your healthcare professional.
