Brief description of the problem

The product is being recalled following a mix-up between 0.5% w/v and 1% w/v strengths of the Efinox Nasal Drops during the labeling and packing process of the above batches.

Action for healthcare professionals

Stop supplying the above batches immediately. Quarantine all remaining stock and await contact from Laboratory and Allied Limited, Kenya, who will contact healthcare professionals directly to arrange the return.

Action for patients and caregivers

Patients currently prescribed Efinox 1% (Ephedrine Hydrochloride Nasal Drops) Batch No. 82979 and 82978, should be contacted by their prescribing healthcare professional. This is because you require a review with your prescribing healthcare professional to discuss alternative treatment options.
