The Pharmacy and Poisons Board has mandated Topstone Pharma Limited, to conduct an urgent recall of Medzol (Metronidazole 400mg) Tablets Batch No. 230940, due to out-of-specification results on the test for Uniformity of weight.

Action for healthcare professionals

Quarantine all remaining stock and stop further distribution, sale, issuing or use of the above batches immediately. Await contact from Topstone Pharma Limited to arrange the return.

Action for patients and caregivers

No further action is required by patients as this is a Retail/hospital Pharmacy and Wholesaler/Distributor level recall
