The Pharmacy and Poisons Board has mandated Pro Med Pharmaceuticals Limited to initiate an urgent recall of Paragen Injection Batch Number K4290027 identified in the Kenyan market, which had exhibited a color change to black.

Action for healthcare professionals

Quarantine all remaining stock and stop further distribution, sale, issuing, or use of the above batches immediately. Await contact from Pro Med Pharmaceuticals Limited to arrange the return.

Action for patients and caregivers

No further action is required by patients as this product is usually administered by healthcare professionals in a hospital setting, and the recall is a Retail/Hospital Pharmacy and Wholesaler/Distributor level recall.
