Brief description of the problem

Following Risk-Based Post-Market Surveillance Activities, the Pharmacy and Poisons Board sampled and tested Leocef (Cefalexin) Powder for Oral Suspension Batch Number 88579 and found that it did not meet the required specifications for the visual appearance whereby brown visible contaminants were observed. PPB has therefore mandated the recall of this product batch from the market.

Action for healthcare professionals

Quarantine all remaining stock and stop further distribution, sale, issuing, or use of Leocef (Cefalexin) Powder for Oral Suspension Batch Number 88579 immediately, and contact Laboratory and Allied Ltd to arrange return.

Action for patients and caregivers

Patients are advised to talk to their healthcare professional if they have the above batch of Leocef.
