The voluntary recall has been initiated due to an observation of a change in physical stability characterized by loss of flowability, resulting in the suspension not exhibiting the expected physical characteristics for normal administration.

Action for healthcare professionals

Quarantine all remaining stock and stop further distribution, sale, issuing, or use of Flazart Batch No. WL25024, WL25025 and WL25026 immediately and contact WIN-PHARMA LTD to arrange return.

Action for patients and caregivers

Patients are advised to talk to their healthcare professional if they have the above batch of Flazart.
